## NJGPA Overview (1 of 2)

- Statute requires the State graduation proficiency assessment to be administered to all grade 11 students. (N.J.S.A. 18A:7C-6)
- NJGPA is designed to measure the extent to which students are graduation ready in English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics.
- Graduation readiness is reported separately for each content component.
- The ELA component is aligned to the grade 10 standards.
- The Mathematics component is aligned to Algebra I and Geometry standards.


## NJGPA Overview (2 of 2)

- On May 3, 2023, the New Jersey State Board of Education adopted the proficiency level cut score for the English language Arts (ELA) and mathematics components of the NJGPA, as well as the menu of alternative assessments and aligned cut scores.
- Students who take but do not meet the minimum required score on each component of the assessment will have the opportunity to receive additional supports and may take the following steps:
- Retake the ELA and/or mathematics components of the New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment in the following summer or fall;
- Meet a designated cut score from the menu of substitute competency tests; or
- Complete a portfolio appeal.


## Participation

- 251 students took the NJGPA in English Language Arts
- 253 students took the NJGPA in Mathematics

## Notable Achievements

- Increase in the number of students who are graduation ready.
- Students who are graduation ready exceeded the state average in Math
- While close to the state average in ELA, continued work needs to be done in this area.


## Intervention Strategies (1 of 2)

- Restructured intervention courses at TOIS and OTHS to better prepare students for the state assessments
- In-depth analysis of NJGPA Evidence Statements to identify sub-performing standards relative to the state of NJ
- Use the NJGPA data to ensure classwork models the same level of rigor.
- Supervisors will continue to hold data meetings with teachers to discuss next steps for intervention implementation


## Intervention Strategies (2 of 2)

- Continue to develop coaching conversations with students to help them to better understand their strengths and strategies for improving performance
- Working on changing school culture around test-taking in an effort to restore a sense of always doing our best without creating undue stress and anxiety around test performance
- Offer additional academic support to identified students
