Legislation

August 2022

Governor Murphy signed legislation N.J.S.A. 18A:17-43.4

Requires the establishment of Threat Assessment Teams in public schools

Purpose of the teams:

- Identify students of concern
- Assess students for level of risk
- Prevent targeted violence



Threat Assessment Definition

A threat assessment is a data gathering process that is non-adversarial, focused primarily on problem-solving and identifying if a person is on a pathway to violence, and determining if we can help the individual to solve their problem, fix their situation, or address their condition in a nonviolent way.

Threat Assessment is not discipline

The key is accurate reporting and quick reaction of the team to gather information and assemble it for a decision.



Requirements for School Districts

- Establish a multidisciplinary threat assessment team
- Define prohibited and concerning behaviors
- Create a central reporting mechanism
- Define a threshold for law enforcement intervention
- Establish threat assessment procedures
- Develop risk management options
- Create and promote safe school climates
- Conduct training for all stakeholders
- Create BOE Policy for Threat Assessment

Training Required

Threat Assessment Team members must participate in a mandated training by NJDOE provided by The Office of Homeland Security

Threat Assessment Process

1. Identify persons of concern
2. Gather information and investigate
3. Assess person and situation
4. Manage the person and situation
