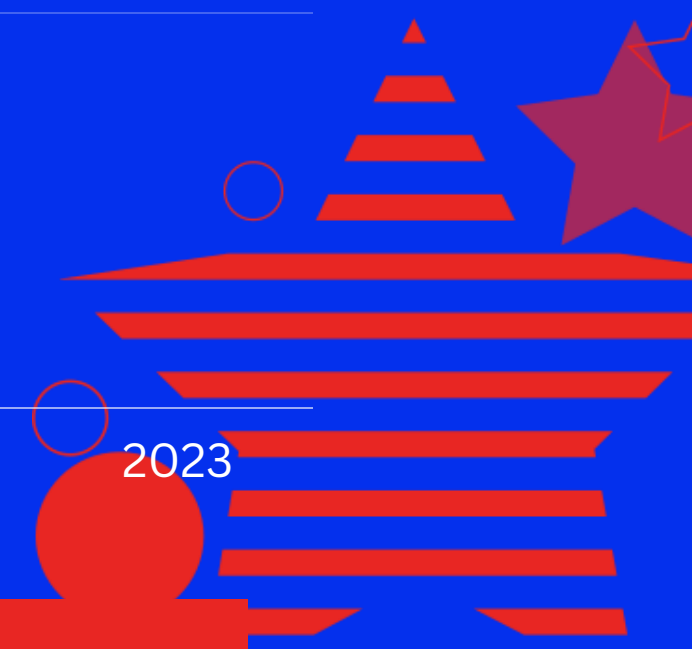
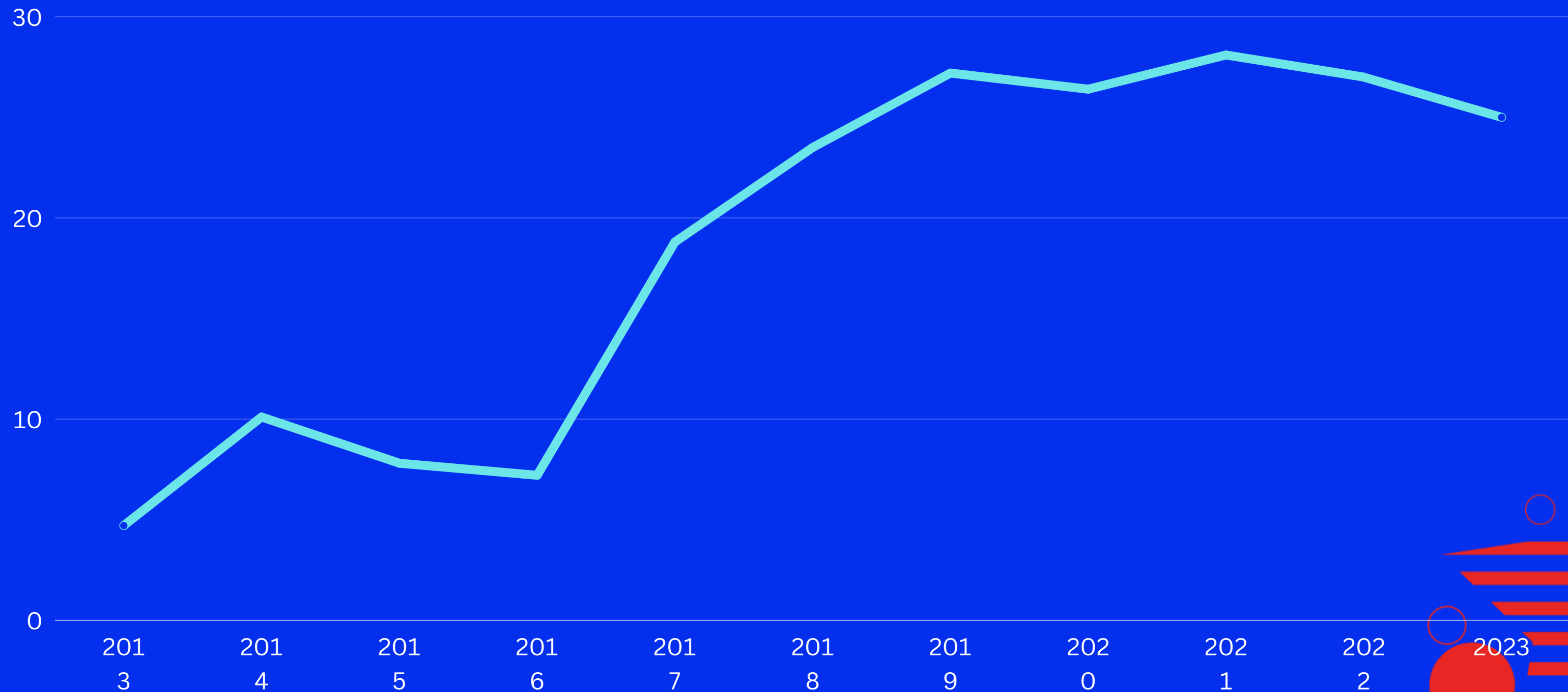
College % Optimization

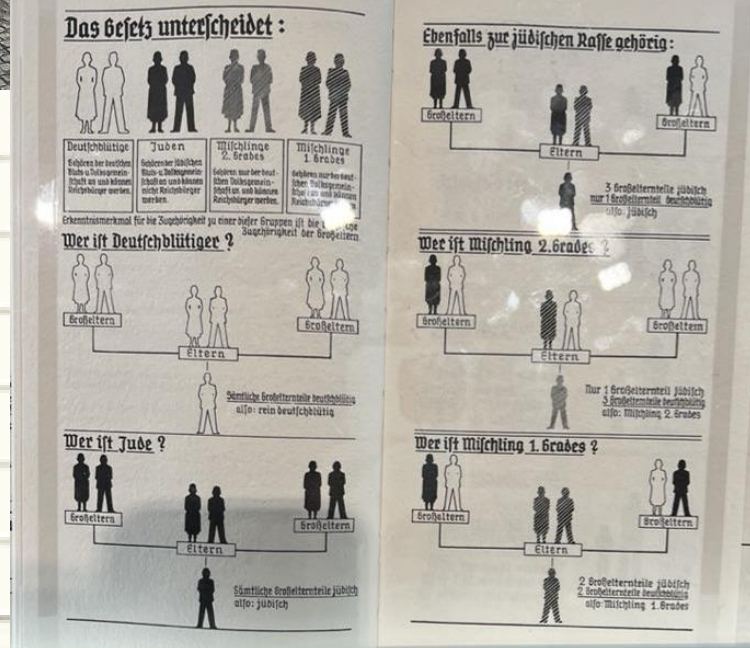

Andrée Geulen, a teacher, is a member of a Belgian resistance group. She collects young children and teenagers from their Jewish parents and places them with families and in monasteries. To carry out this task she learns names and addresses by heart. She fills out this notebook in secret. It contains the names, ages and addresses of over a thousand people in hiding.

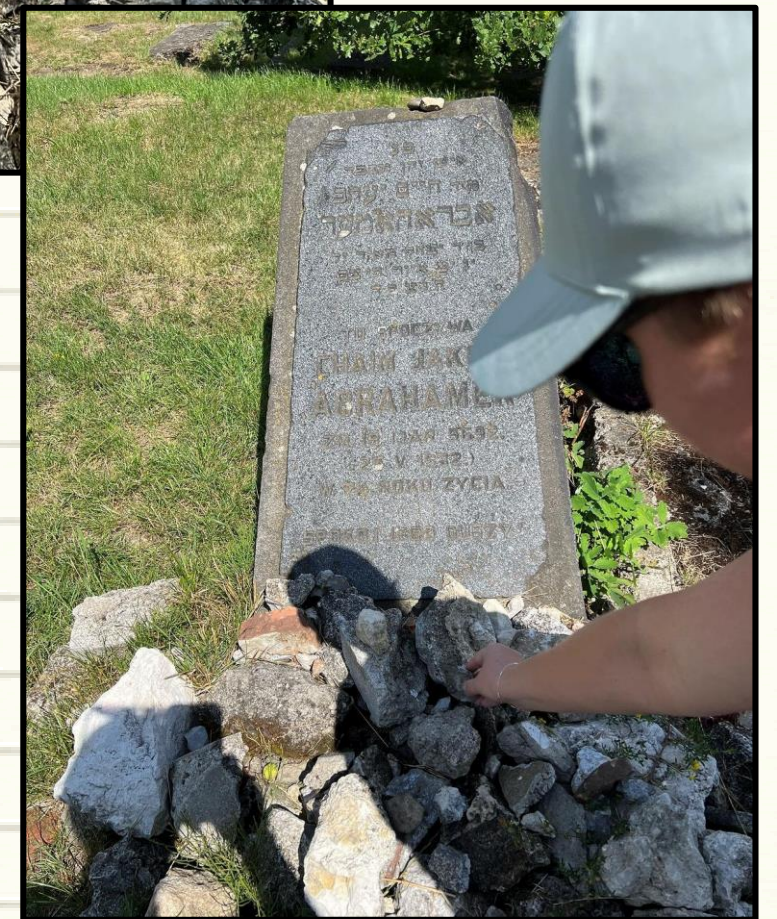
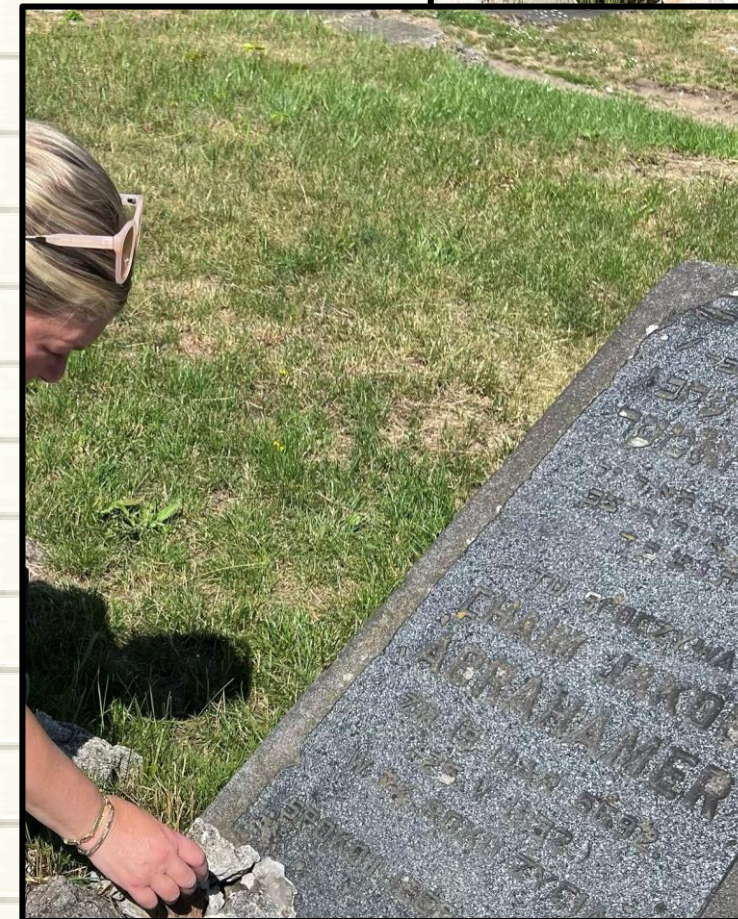

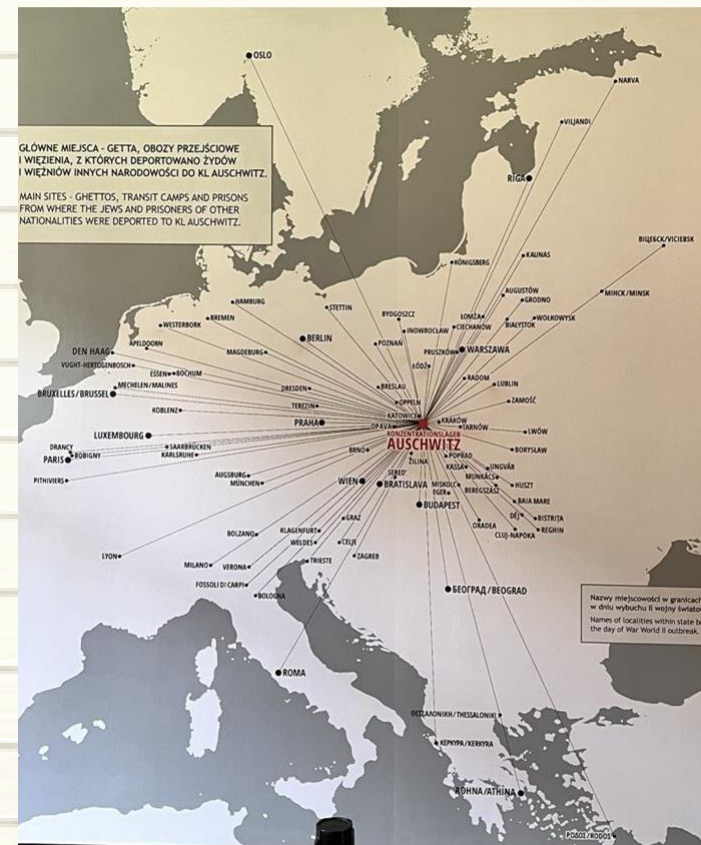

Julian Grobelny „Trojan”, (ur. 1893) był pierwszym przewodniczącym Rady Pomocy Żydom. „Sam znajdując się w ciężkich warunkach materialnych, bez stałego locum w Warszawie ..., u kresu ostatniego wyczerpania fizycznego z powodu bardzo zaawansowanej gruźlicy płuc, ścigany ustawicznie przez Gestapo, był wszędzie tam, gdzie trzeba było zorganizować konkretną pomoc lub rozwiązywać najtrudniejsze problemy. Pogodny, bardzo opanowany, z dużym poczuciem humoru” – wspominała go po wojnie Irena Sandlerowa.

Julian Grobelny “Trojan”, born in 1893, was the first president of the Council to Aid Jews. “Himself struggling with a tough financial situation, with no steady room in Warsaw ... emaciated physically by advanced tuberculosis, chased after by the Gestapo, he was always there, wherever help needed to be organised or problems solved. Cheerful, composed, with a great sense of humour”, recalled Irena Sandler after the war.

One of the many things that is important to me is people's stories. So many lives were lost and involved in the Holocaust. I tried to bring back as many people's memories as I could.

Tema was in contact with partisans and bought weapons. She crossed the eastern border of the Generalgouvernement and also travelled to the Third Reich. She was the first to break the news of the Ponary executions.

Bela operated in Grodno and Białystok. In spring 1942, she was arrested and sent to Auschwitz.

Lonka knew German, Russian, Ukrainian, and other languages, a major asset for a courier. Her forged papers identified her as a Pole – Krystyna Kosowska. In 1942, while returning from Vilna, she was arrested for carrying weapons and underground literature. She was deported to the Auschwitz concentration camp as a Polish political prisoner.

When war broke out, Maria Majerczyk and her 8-year-old daughter, Joanna, escaped from Łódź to Warsaw. From the outset, they used forged Aryan documents. Maria took many jobs, worked with Żegota, helped members of her family in hiding. She put her daughter into an orphanage run by nuns in the Warsaw suburb of Chotomów.

Joanna was one of a dozen Jewish children who were helped by the nuns. Maria visited her daughter once a week, and always brought her camera and took photographs of her daughter, her friends, and nuns.
