

Due to continuity of the new blocks of time, teachers should see an approximate increase of 'meat and potato time' in all areas (except ELA) by 800 minutes or 19.512 days of instructional time based compared to our current schedule. That is a 10.4% increase in instructional time just by taking opening and closing from 10 days over two week period to five days over a two week period.
