Special Education Services

In Class Resource or Pull Out Resource Replacement

- Assignments will be differentiated and modified to meet the specific needs of the students.

SC Learning Language Disabled or SC Multiply Disabled

- Assignments will be easily accessible for all students depending on skill level. Upon return, students participating in these programs will need to be assessed for regression.

Multi-sensory reading program

- Assignments and activities will help students maintain progress.



IEP Meetings

- Annual reviews and standing IEP meetings will occur to the greatest extent possible via videoconferencing software such as Google Hangout or Meet, Zoom Meeting or by a teleconference.
- Your case managers will be in contact with you to facilitate.



Special Education Related Services

- **Speech Language Pathologists, Occupational Therapists, and Physical Therapists** will provide related services therapies to students through electronic communications, virtual, remote, or other online platforms, as appropriate and as required by the student's IEP to the greatest extent possible.

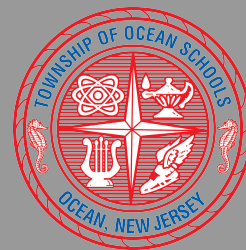
